The Memorial Minute Adopted by the University of New Mexico Faculty, May 14, 1963, remembers Dr. Duncan in the following way: Julian S. Duncan, a former faculty member and chair of the Department of Economics at UNM, is remembered as “much more than an economist and teacher. He was a warm and sympathetic person who took upon his own shoulders many problems of this colleagues and students; several students would not have graduated had it not been for his encouragement and assistance. Beneath an unpretentious demeanor lay a firm resolve to do what was right and to lend what assistance he could.” The Department is accepting applications for up to two scholarships of \$1000 each, which will be awarded to promising students who are interested in the economic development of Latin America.

When submitting your application, be sure to submit the following:

- ❖ For the Julian S. Duncan Scholarship, submit a 1-2 page essay detailing your demonstrated interest in Latin America.
- The above information completed
- Current Unofficial Transcript
- A CV (resume)
- A written statement.
 - Please have your recommending Economics professor review your statement as it carries considerable weight in determining the awards.
 - Be sure to specify which award you are applying for.
- A letter of recommendation from one Economics faculty member.
 - Please ask your recommender to submit the recommendation directly to Daniela Wilken, either in person or by email.
- A brief description of your financial need, including how this award will make a difference to your studies
 - No more than 1 page.
- Recipients will need to write a short summary of what they accomplished to be returned to the Department of Economics by December 31, 2016.

Recipients will have from Fall 2016 to the end of Spring 2017 to apply the funds toward their project.
