This award is made possible by an endowment from J. Raymond Stuart, UNM class of 1932. The award is designed to provide a deserving undergraduate or graduate student with financial assistance for specific expenses related to their professional development such as the purchase of otherwise unavailable data sets, subject fees for experiments, travel to professional meetings, or other purposes necessary for professional development. One award of up to \$500 to support scholarly activities is available for a graduate student to defray expenses related to research or other scholarly activities.

To apply, complete the attached application form. In addition, provide a current CV and an unofficial transcript. A letter of recommendation from your major advisor must also be submitted by the application deadline.

The recipient is required to provide a written update at the end of the fellowship detailing the results from the award. They are also required to write a thank you letter to the donor's family at the time of receiving the award. The letter will be provided to the Department of Economics and then forwarded to the donor's family.
