

Graduate Application Checklist

The Department of Economics admits for the Fall term only. Please do not apply for Spring or Summer as your application will not be reviewed.

February 15th: This is the preferred graduate international application deadline for all international applicants including those seeking financial aid.

July 1st: Domestic Applicants not seeking financial aid

- Statement of Intent - must include field of interest and previous math courses that you take over the past years to help you prepare for the Economics Graduate Program
- Three letters of recommendation
- For Domestic and International students please provide current GRE Scores no older than 3 years at time of submission of your application and for International students please provide current TOEFL or IELTS scores
- TOEFL or IELTS scores
- CV required (curriculum vitae or resume, including current contact information)
- Transcripts from each institution of higher learning that the applicant has attended.

All official transcripts must be sent directly to the Admissions Office (domestic and international applicants) and the Global Education Office (international applicants).

Please have each school send your official transcript to the UNM Admissions Office directly. Admission is provisional until the Admissions Office receives a complete, final and official transcript verifying graduation or completion. Transcripts must be in a sealed envelope from the issuing college / school, or transmitted through an accepted provider.
